SCORE SHEET



The score sheet will be divided up into 4 categories. The following three categories will be worth 30 points each; General Appearance, Conformation and Coat. The fourth category, Fitting and Handling will be worth 10 points.

General Appearance: 30 points

- Breed Type
- Size
- Balance and Symmetry
- Presence
- Style

Conformation: 30 points

- Head
- Neck
- Topline
- Chest and Front Legs (width, straightness and proper angles)
- Rump and Rear Legs (width, straightness of legs and proper angles)
- Blending

Coat: 30 points

- Overall Coverage and consistency in length
- Neck, chest and facial hair
- Length of coat
- Condition
 - Richness of coat color (Any color or combination of colors is acceptable)
 - Luster
 - Silkeness

The coat should look healthy and shiny.

Fitting and Handling: 10 points

- Cleanliness of the animal and the handler should be considered.
- Courtesy and kindness to animals and other exhibitors in the ring should be noted and rewarded or penalized, especially if a handler is being impatient or unkind to a goat in a stiffened condition in the ring, whether it's the handler's goat or the goat of a competitor.

Notes to Judges:

Bites: To health reasons, should there be a concern about the bite, we request that judges ask exhibitors to show the bite rather than have the judges place their hands in each goat's mouth.

Mammary System: The Mini Silky is not a dairy breed; the mammary system is not on the score card or in the breed standard and therefore should not be evaluated or considered when placing animals in the classes.

At the end of the show, the MSFGA does NOT require judges to verify winning goat's height, tattoos or other ID.
